The Colfax Museum to Host Pop-up Event and Announcement on July 6th during 40 West Arts First Friday

Jonny Barber, owner-blogger at colfaxavenue.com and founder and executive director of The Colfax Museum, will hold a pop-up event at The Pasternack Arts Hub (6851 W. Colfax) in [40 West Arts District](#) on Friday, July 6, from 5-9pm—with a special announcement scheduled for 7pm.

“This is an exciting time!” said Barber, who worked with locals to form a nonprofit and assemble a board of directors for the museum. “We’ve been in conversations for months with the folks here on West Colfax. Now we’re ready to make an announcement about the future of The Colfax Museum.”

This First Friday—just steps from the newly launched [ArtLine](#) and adjacent to [NEXT](#) Gallery—Barber plans to display a few select items from the museum’s 1000+ item collection and, according to Barber, reunite Sid King’s Crazy Horse neon sign with the iconic mannequin that was once part of the saloon’s entrance. “It’s the first time the two will be together in 35 years,” explained Barber.

Attendees can also become a part of a museum exhibit. The event will include a group photo of all who attend the 7pm announcement. Organizers plan to frame the photo and include it in The Colfax Museum.
