





Vision 2040 - Corridor Focus Area




Primarily focusing on commercial & public areas between Welch and Sheridan in Lakewood's W. Colfax corridor



- 40 West Arts designated State-Certified Creative District in June 2014






Review Rating Approach




- Two Ratings: Performance Index and Importance Index
 - Core Team Ratings to arrive at a Performance Index
 - Each team members rates each Action Item on the following scale



- Ambassadors Ratings to arrive at Importance Index
 - Each Ambassador rates every goals on **a 1 to 10 scale** on his/her perception of importance In future meetings, Group will prioritize goals per section (and discuss NEW goals)




